The highest denomination of US currency ever issued is $\mathbf{\$ 1 0 0 , 0 0 0}$.
Fractional notes down to $3 \$$ were issued when people hoarded coins during the Civil War.

Paper currency is signed by the Secretary of the Treasury.
The serial number prefix indicates the issuing Federal Reserve Bank:
